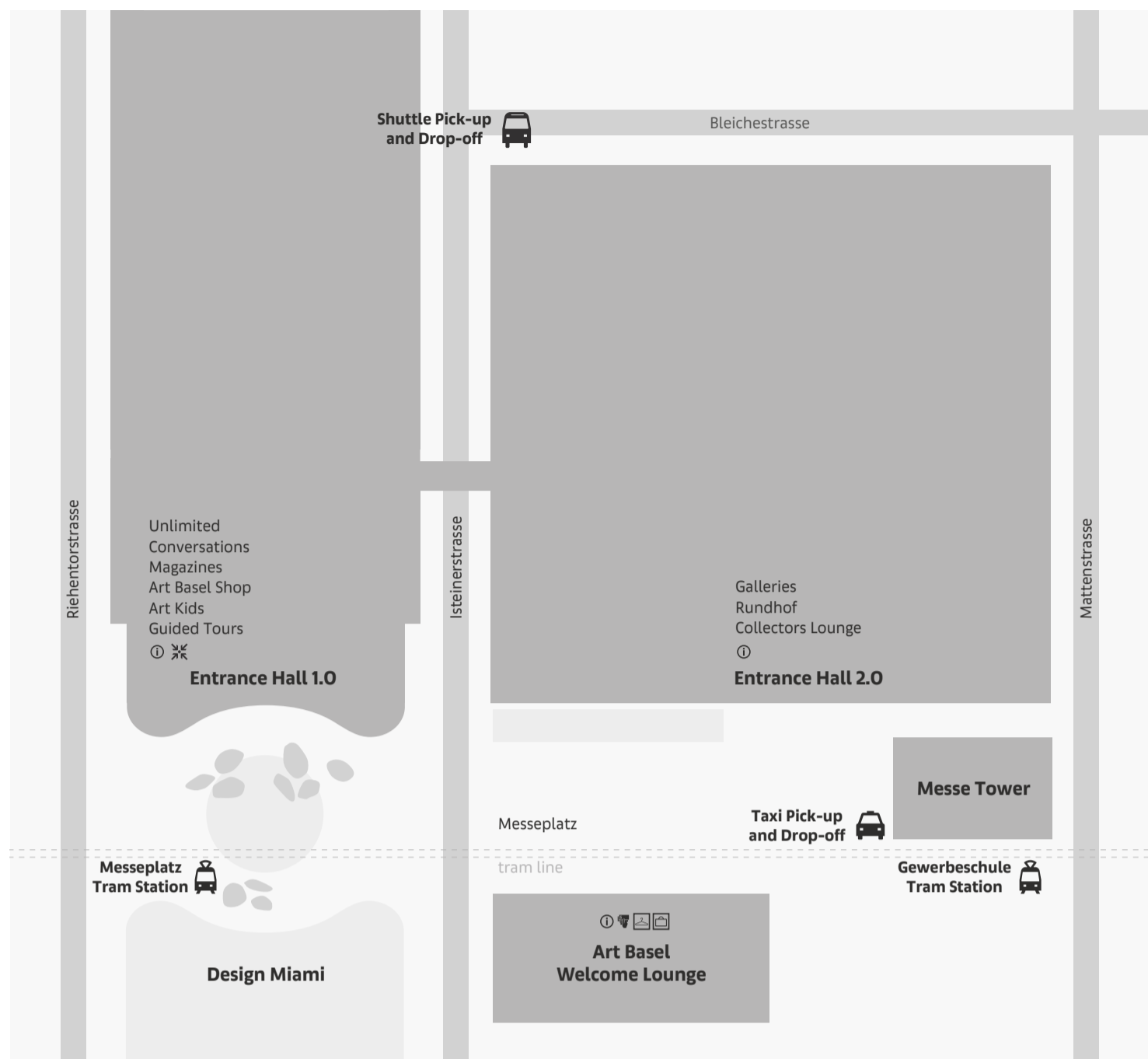


Art Basel Area Map
